Bennet Pass to Bonnie Junction	B	9	840	Hood	Follows road for gentle climb to summit, cross terrible traverse, to Bonnie Junction
Bennet Pass to terrible traverse	A	5	400	Hood	Gentle road tour, out and back. Route turns around at terrible traverse. Old growth
Bennet Pass Loop	B	12	840	Hood	Follows road for gentle climb to summit, cross terrible traverse, to Pocket Creek
Bennet Pass to Bonnie Butte	C	12	885	Hood	Ski Bennet Pass to Bonnie Junction to Bonnie Butte
Clark Creek Trail	A,B Novice	2 to 8	50	Hood	Easy skiing through old growth forest & meadows. Excellent views of Mt Hood
Clear Lake/North Shore	Novice	2 to 5		Hood	Wonderful clear cuts and logging roads
Coud Cap Inn	C	12	2 120	Hood	Cloud Cap Inn via Old Wagon Rd. Bring your skins
Crazy Hills/Wind River	B	12	600	Gorge	Lone Butte snow park. Ski road to open view. Need downhill skills
Elk Meadows	C	8	760	Hood	Ascend steep forest to Elk Meadows through Clark & Newton Creek trails
Enid Lake	Novice,A	2.5	50	Hood	Across from Ski Bowl loops ranging from 1.5 to 2.5 miles. Up and down hills
Frog Lake Butte	B	6	1 300	Hood	Steep road climb going up to flat area. Fast, tight downhill ski out.
Gates of the Mountain/Clark Creek	B	8	1 800	Hood	Gentle ascent, turning skills in trees required.
Ghost Ridge	C	12	800	Hood	Twin Lakes loop augmented with a side trip up to Ghost Ridge
Glade Trail	B	4	-1950	Hood	Possible groomed from Timberline down. Demands edging and turning
Gravel Pit/White River	Novice	1	100	Hood	Gentle slopes along marked ski trail offering practice areas for skiers of all levels
Hard Time Loop	B	11.2	700	Gorge	Upper Wind River Usually machine groomed
Heather Canyon	B	8	800	Hood	Start at Clark Creek snow trail then bushwack to Heather Canyon
June Lake	B	5	550	St. Helens	Ski up to June Lake connect with Swift Creek trail
Kalama Ski Trail	B,C	up to 16	300	St. Helens	Incredible views. Trail traverses Mt St Helens at the 3500 ft level east/west. Out and back route.
Kinzel Lake	C++	23.4	2 920	Hood	Long ski, need lots of water and food. Fast long, long day. Best views on last 4.6 miles out
Lamberson Butte	C	12	2 400	Hood	Switchback hiking trail. Wilderness trip
Little Crater Lake	C	13.2	240	Hood	Beautiful meadow inspiring view of Hood on wide road
Lookout Mountain	C	18.8	3 245	Hood	Backcountry wilderness tour following road
Lost Lake	B	12	1 500	Hood	Road to lake w/spendid scenery
Mann Butte	B	10	700	Trout Lake	Marked and unmarked roads. Avoids snowmobiles. Great views.
Marble Mountain	B	11.6	1 500	St. Helens	Spectacular views of St. Helens and Rainier. B level formilage
Mineral Jane	B	9		Hood	Start out on Mineral Jane trail and head for Barlow Butte
Monitor Ridge	B	12	1 210	St. Helens	Fairly easy on Forest Service roads with play hills
Mud Creek Loop	B	10	1 200	Hood	Trillium Lake extention leaves main trail and continue for 5 additional miles
Muddy River Lahar	B	10	350	St. Helens	Pine Martin Trail then to open ski area
Newton Creek from Hwy 26	Novice	2	100	Hood	Old Growth Forest, easy ski tour, starts from Hwy 26. Limited parking
Old Maid Flats I	A	5.6	400	Hood	Lolo Pass Road area. Gentle road to Ramona Falls
Old Maid Flats II	C	12	1 480	Hood	Dense forest, climbs moderately along Sandy River. Return same or via Ramona Creek
Old Man Pass Loop	B	5.7	400	Gorge	Upper Wind River north of Carson. Delightful route on marked trails and road
Pine Martin Trail	A	6	200	St. Helens	Starts at Marble Mtn Snow Park. Parallels snowmobile road; can create loops to lengthen trip
Pioneer Road Loops	Novice	1.8	50	Hood	Unmarked segments of Barlow road, mostly level
Pocket Creek	Novice	5.4	400	Hood	Wide road with gentle hills
Pocket Creek Loop	B	7	400	Hood	Just before summit take trail to open play area. Then into woods for more technical skiing
Red Rock Pass/Lava	B	6	420	St. Helens	Ski road to pass then short climb to Lava plateau to views
Robin Hood Loop	Novice, A	up to 5	100	Hood	New trail across from Pocket Creek. Rebuilt in 2004 by ONC.
Rush Creek Loop	Novice	3	60	Adams	Exceptional sweeping views. Open space through clear cuts.

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Sahalie Falls	A	3.6	100	Hood	Follows road for easy ski in and out. Starts at Hood River Meadows Snow Park
Salmon River Meadows	Novice	4	400	Hood	Large meadow, need good snow pack. Winding banks of Ghost Creek offer lovely tour
Sasquatch Trail Loops	B	7		St. Helens	Follows old logging roads, gentle grade
Sherar Burn Road	C	8.8	1 000	Hood	Mostly road, good workout
Swift Creek Trail	B	5.4	840	Hood	Strenuous uphill route. Winterclimbing route to the summit
Tea Cup Lake	A	1-7+	100	Hood	ONC Groomed trail complex. \$3 donation/person
Trillium Lake	A	5	450	Hood	Ski down road to flat trail around the lake
Twin Lakes	B	9.7	1 100	Hood	Trail runs through fabulous old forests and down to two lakes. Best early in the season
Wapati Trail Loop	A	5	100	St. Helens	Series of meadows with splendid views with Wapiti Creek flowing through
West Leg Trail	B	10	1 950	Hood	5 mile uphill climb on old Timberline Lodge Road. Descend on same
White River I	Novice,A	1 to 5	0 to 300	Hood	Starts out flat and gradually slopes up and back
Windy Peak	C	10+	2 000	Hood	East of Bennet Pass, untracked snow, drop down into Pocket Creek. Car shuttle required
Wolf Run	A,B	up to 10	300	Hood	East side by Dufur. New ski area with gentle hills
Wygant Basin	A, B	up to 10	400	Hood	Open area with great views of Mt Adams. Easy hills. TH parking north of Cooper Spur Inn.
Yellow Jacket	B/C	12.6	800	Hood	Level of difficulty depends on snow conditions. Car shuttle
Zig Zag Canyon/Lower	B			Hood	West of Timberline Lodge. Scattered islands of sub-alpine trees. Up and down terrain
Zig Zag Canyon/Upper	B	3.4		Hood	Although not difficult requires downhill ski skills
